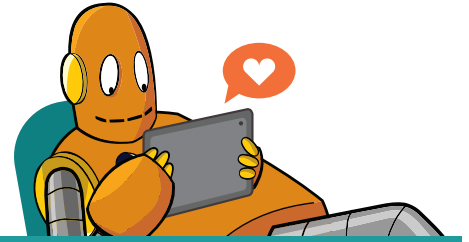
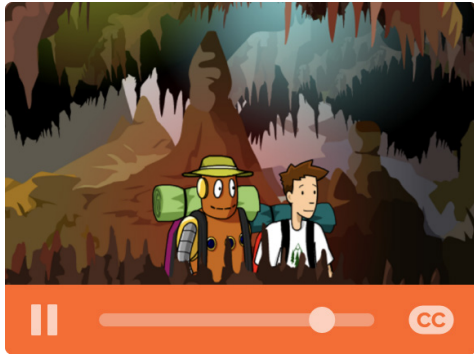

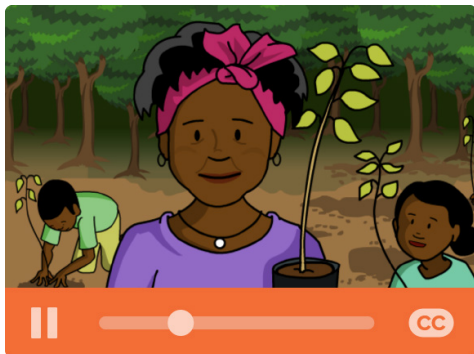
WATCH A MOVIE
