

Track student understanding of each activity and each question within it (and how it compares to the class average).




Understand student performance on literacy skills emphasized in their grade-level state ELA standards.



Plan differentiated instruction with easy-to-read benchmarks, filtering, and reassigning.


Assignment Progress

- Reassign activities to specific students directly from the report




Activity Progress
