#### Movie (10 minutes)

#### **Topics with Pause Points**

- Select a grade-banded Pause Point set based on students' needs.
- Use one of these strategies: whole group discussion, voting, or turn-and-talk.

#### **Topics without Pause Points**

• View and discuss: What did you notice or want to know more about?



#### **Movie with Pause Points (10 minutes)**

Assign a grade-banded Pause Point set based on the needs of each small group.



#### Vocab Builder (15-20 minutes)

- Assign level based on needs of each small group.
- Preview and discuss all words or focus on specific word(s) based on data or instructional focus.



#### Leveled Reading (15-20 minutes)

- Use the sort feature in the Standards Performance Report to inform grouping.
- · Assign text level based on the reading needs of each small group.



#### Quiz - Practice Mode (15-20 min)

- Discuss each question.
- Prompt students to support each choice with evidence.
- · Address misconceptions.



#### Movie with Pause Points (10-15 min)

Assign a Pause Point set based on student's needs.



#### Quiz - Graded or Practice Mode (15-20 min)

Assign level based on student's needs using Standards Performance Report.



#### Leveled Reading - Graded or Practice Mode (15-20 min)

Assign based on student's reading level.



#### **Vocab Builder (10-15 minutes)**

- Assign a leveled word set based on student's needs.
- Use Teacher Reports data from this activity to inform future lesson planning.



#### **Creative Tools (20+ minutes)**

- Assign Make-a-Movie and/or Creative Coding.
- Student creates an artifact to show their learning.
